
LOW LEVEL ACCESS SLIDING DOOR


Make sure the tray is 100% level in all directions. Do not attempt to install the product unless you can tick all 4 boxes satisfactorily.


•	Check that you have the tools required

•	Check the installation kit is complete	


The wall plugs supplied with the installation kit are for use in solid walls. Hollow or 'stud partition' wall will require alternative fixings. Please consult a hardware supplier for the correct type. It may also be necessary to consult your tiling supplier about the correct method for drilling your tiles.

ATTENTION: TAKE EXTREME CARE WHEN HANDLING GLASS, WEAR PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR AND CLOTHING. DO NOT LEAVE THE GLASS ON HARD SURFACES AND AVOID CONTACT BETWEEN THE GLASS EDGES AND HARD SURFACES OR IMPACTS DURING THE INSTALLATION.





Determine your step in from the edge of the tray. 20mm is recommended. Plumb your wall profiles on each side then mark and drill your fixing positions. You can then remove your wall profiles and begin the frame assembly off the tray.


Ambient American Step in from the edge of the tray. 20mm is recommended. Plumb your wall profiles and drill your fixing positions. You can then remove your wall profiles and begin the frame assembly off the tray.












When fitting a fully framed product into a recess you must push the wall profiles onto the uprights. This is done as fixing the wall profiles first in a tight recess may lead to difficulty later when fitting your door.



Lift the frame including wall profiles onto the tray and then fix your wall profiles to the walls using the fixing screws provided.





NOTE! Fix the screw through the center of the slot. This is necessary to allow enough room either side for the screw cover caps


10A. Equalise the adjustment of the frame in the wall profile on both sides. 10B. From inside drill the frame top, middle and bottom making sure to step in a Min. 14mm from the edge of the frame. 10C. Fix the frame with screws and cover clips. 10D. Fix cover caps. Take care not to drill 10C to the glass 10A 2SS009 2SY50 C056 (Ø3mm) 10B 10D X2 X1=X2 X=0~20 2SS008




- A. Fit the rollers to the top of the door.
 - B. Hang the door onto the track.
 - C. Press the button on the bottom guide and bring the moving panel over the guide and release the button. D. Push on the anti-jump strip over the top edge of the track, this will secure the door on the track.









Use a quality silicone to seal the finished door.

Seal on the outside along the wall profile and the wall.

Seal on the outside along the bottom between the tray and the fixed glass panel, guide block and the threshold strip.

Seal 50mm vertically between the frame and the wall profile.

DO NOT SILICONE THE ENCLOSURE FOR 24 HOURS AFTER SEALING.
