Introduction

Specification

Designed to comply with BS EN 274-1:2002 Waste fittings for sanitary appliances.

Cleaning & Maintenance

Your fitting has a high quality finish and should be treated with care to preserve the visible surfaces.

All finishes will wear if not cleaned correctly. The only safe way to clean your product is to wipe with a soft damp cloth. Stains can be removed using washing up liquid. All bathroom cleaning product (powders and liquids) will damage the surface of your fitting, even the non-scratch cleaners.


NOTE:- Never use abrasive detergents or disinfectants or those containing alcohol, hydrochloric or phosphoric acid.

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4. Installation

Slotted Wastes -


- 1. Identify all components are present prior to installation.
- 2. Unscrew the backnut (4) & remove one of the rubber washers (2/3). Fit the waste above the basin with the first washer. Locate the bottom waste.
- 3. Secure waste with backnut (4) & the second washer.
- 4. In order to fill the basin, the 'Clicker' mechanism of the waste needs to be pressed down. To release the water, press the button again.
- 5. Check all joints & connections for leaks.
- 6. See page 3 for aftercare instructions.

Unslotted Wastes -

- Identify all components are present prior to installation.
- 2. Unscrew the clicker mechanism (5) from the flange (4).
- 3. Fit the rubber washer (3) onto the waste flange (4). Then place them above the basin.
 Fit the rubber washer (2) and backnut (1) to the flange (4), then tighten the backnut (1).
 (DONOTOVERTIGHTEN)
- 4. Screw the clicker mechanism (5) back into the flange. (DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN)
- 5. Check all joints and connections for leaks.
- 6. See page 3 for aftercare instructions.

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
